CHAPTER 1

User's Guide

1.1 Installation

1.1.1 Compatibility

- Python 3.8, 3.9, 3.10, and 3.11 (recommended)
- Django 3.2 LTS, and 4.2 LTS (recommended)
- PostgreSQL (recommended), MySQL, Oracle Database and SQLite

Constrained by What Python version can I use with Django?

1.1.2 Get started

New in Spirit 0.5

Latest version can be installed through pip:

1. Install Spirit:

pip install django-spirit

2. Start your site:

spirit startproject mysite

3. Set up the database:

```
cd mysite python manage.py spiritinstall
```

4. Create an administrator account:

```
python manage.py createsuperuser
python manage.py runserver
```

Now sign in at http://127.0.0.1:8000/

1.1.3 Side notes

This will run using the *developer* settings. Running a production site is out of the scope of this documentation. However there are many guides about running a Django site out there.

Here are some hints:

- On production, create a prod_local.py, import the production settings from .prod import * and override settings such as DATABASES and ALLOWED_HOSTS.
- Gunicorn and Nginx are a common way of running Python sites.
- An email server is required. There are self-hosted ones (ie: exim), and managed ones (ie: Postmark).
- A search engine is required. Woosh comes configured by default, however is quite slow. A better choice may be elastic-search.

1.2 Upgrade

Warning: Make a database backup before upgrading to avoid data loss, you have been warned. Use the pg_dump command on PostgreSQL or mysqldump on MySQL. You can also create a backup running python python manage.py dumpdata --indent=4 > database.json. You may want to backup the media folder as well.

1.2.1 Upgrade a minor version

Trying to skip a minor version while upgrading will break things. For example, it's not possible to upgrade from v0.4.x to v0.6.x without upgrading to v0.5.x first.

Make sure to check the changelog for every patch version of the upgrade target, and make changes accordingly; ex: added/removed installed apps, new settings, etc. Check the Django logs for Spirit deprecation warnings.

Run the install command. Replace x by the next minor version. Replace y by the latest patch version:

pip install --upgrade django-spirit==0.x.y

Run the upgrade command. This command will run migrate, rebuild_index, and collectstatic:

python manage.py spiritupgrade

1.2.2 Upgrade a patch version

Unlike minor versions, it's possible to skip patch versions, ex: upgrade from v0.4.x to v0.4.xx. This is because patch versions should not introduce breaking changes. However, it's advised to always backup the data base, media folder, and current setup if at all possible. Upgrades are not risk free.

1.2.3 Upgrade from +v0.1 to v0.4

Read the Wiki.

1.3 Task Manager

Spirit ships with several tasks that run asynchronously. The supported task managers to run these tasks are Huey, and Celery.

While Spirit can run without a task manager, some of the tasks may not run, as they are too expensive to run as part of the request-response cycle (web server), or they are require to be run periodically.

Functionality that requires a task manager includes: search indexation.

1.3.1 Huey

Read the Huey docs for Django.

Install

Run:

pip install django-spirit[huey]

Configuration

Set Huey as the Spirit task manager:

```
# settings.py (dev.py or prod.py)
# extend installed apps with +=
INSTALLED_APPS += [
        'huey.contrib.djhuey',
]
ST_TASK_MANAGER = 'huey'
```

The settings/prod.py and settings/dev.py files include sample configuration for Huey. The prod.py settings set Redis as the backend, and the dev.py settings set SQLite as the backend. Redis is recommended for production environments, and it's a good option to use as the Django cache as well.

How to install Redis depends on the OS, for example it can be installed as a Snap package in Ubuntu, or it can be run with docker. So, it's out of the scope of these docs.

Run the tasks consumer

To start the task manager, run:

python manage.py run_huey

This can be run with supervisord, or systemd in production.

The caveats of SQLite as a backend

SQLite only works in single server instances, where both the web-server and the task manager (Huey) are running in the same machine, sharing the same SQLite data base.

For sufficiently large forum instances, it's recommended to run the task manager on its own machine, while the webserver can scale up and down independently. This means Redis must be used instead of SQLite.

Scaling Huey

I'm not aware of how well Huey scales horizontally. It seems it may just work fine. However, all Huey instances but one must disable the periodic task functionality to avoid running periodic tasks in more than one machine. This can be done by passing the --no-periodic parameter to the task manager command.

1.3.2 Celery

Read the Celery docs for Django.

Install

Run:

```
pip install django-spirit[celery]
```

Configuration

Set Celery as the Spirit task manager:

```
# mysite/settings/settings.py (dev.py or prod.py)
```

ST_TASK_MANAGER = 'celery'

Import Celery at Django startup:

```
# mysite/__init__.py
from .celery import app as celery_app
__all__ = ('celery_app',)
```

Run the tasks consumer

To start the task manager, run:

celery -A mysite worker -l info

This can be run with supervisord, or systemd in production.

To start the periodic task manager, run:

celery -A mysite beat -l info

Note this will just enqueue tasks that will later be consumed by the worker.

Celery does not work

Celery likes to break all the things in every major version. The celery configuration (including prod.py, dev.py, and mysite/celery.py) were tested on v4.4.7.

I'm not a Celery user. These docs and the Celery support are a community effort. Please, send a PR if something breaks.

1.4 Templates

Spirit templates can be overridden the regular Django way. The issue with overriding is keeping up with all the changes a new Spirit version may introduce to those templates. To avoid this, Spirit has some specific templates that can be safely overridden.

1.4.1 Extend the HTML head section

Extending the head section is the best way to override the CSS style, add JS scripts, add some font, etc.

Let's override the theme colors to make it green-ish:

```
{ # templates/spirit/_base.html # }
{% extends "spirit/_base.html" %}
{% block custom_head_extra %}

The templates folder must be next to the static and media folders.

There is a bunch more of CSS color variables in the Sass colors file. There is also a dark-mode that is active when the OS is in dark-mode, but it can be set as the default or as the only theme the same way.

1.4.2 Extend other sections

The HTML body can be extended as well, before and after the Spirit layout section. This is useful to add an extra nav-bar at the top, or to add some JS snippet or footer at the bottom.

Let's just add some minimal text this time:

```
{# templates/spirit/_base.html #}
{% extends "spirit/_base.html" %}
{% block custom_before_spirit_body %}
<div style="background-color:yellow;color:black;text-align:center;">
    My extra nav bar
    </div>
    {% endblock %}
    {% block custom_after_spirit_body %}
    <div style="background-color:yellow;color:black;text-align:center;">
    My extra footer
    </div>
    {% endblock %}
    {% endblock %}
```

I've inlined the style in the elements, but a better way is to style things in the head section, see *Extend the HTML head section*.

1.4.3 Customize the site name/logo

The forum name can be set without overriding any template, go to http://127.0.0.1:8000/st/admin/ config/, and change the site name field.

The template can be overridden to include custom HTML, such as an image:

1.5 Settings

These are the default settings. They can be overridden by the project settings

```
ST_ALLOWED_AVATAR_FORMAT = ('jpeg', 'jpg')
The user avatar will be validated against these formats. See the Pillow docs for a list of supported formats
```

Warning: Allowing PNG files is a security risk as it may contain malicious HTML. See Django notes

ST_ALLOWED_UPLOAD_FILE_MEDIA_TYPE = { 'doc': 'application/msword', 'docx': 'application/www.uploaded files will be validated against these formats. This is a map of extension and media-type. Both are used
for validation

Note: To find a media-type just add an extension and an empty media-type, then try uploading a valid file for that extension and the expected media-type will be printed within the validation error. Either that or use the Linux file --mime-type ./my_file command

ST_ALLOWED_UPLOAD_IMAGE_FORMAT = ('jpeg', 'jpg', 'gif')

Uploaded images will be validated against these formats. Also, the file choosing dialog will filter by these extensions. See the Pillow docs for a list of supported formats

Warning: Allowing PNG files is a security risk as it may contain malicious HTML. See Django notes

- ST_ALLOWED_URL_PROTOCOLS = {'ftp', 'ftps', 'git', 'http', 'https', 'irc', 'ircs', 'magnet'
 Link protocols allowed within posts
- ST_CASE_INSENSITIVE_EMAILS = True

Make emails case insensitive

```
ST_CASE_INSENSITIVE_USERNAMES = True
Make user-names case insensitive
```

Note: This can be set to False at any time, however setting it back to True requires taking care of clashing users, i.e: someuser, SomeUser and SoMeUsEr, only one of those users will be able log-in (the one in lowercase). Removing clashing users is usually not possible.

ST_COMMENT_MAX_LEN = 3000

Maximum length for a comment

ST_DOUBLE_POST_THRESHOLD_MINUTES = 30

Minutes to wait before a given user will be able to post a duplicated comment/topic

ST_EXTENDED_FONT = False

Use the extended font variation. Includes Latin, Greek, and Cyrillic charsets

ST_HUEY_SCHEDULE = { 'full_search_index_update': { 'hour': '*/24', 'minute': '0' }, 'notify
Tasks schedule for the Huey task manager. It contains a dict of tasks, and every task a dict of crontab params.
Beware, the default value for every missing param is '*'. See Huey periodic tasks

ST_MATH_JAX = False

Enable MathJax. Spirit's markdown supports math notation with \$, (...), (...) and $begin{abc}... end{abc}$, this merely insert the MathJax script into the HTML.

ST_MENTIONS_PER_COMMENT = 30

Maximum number of mentions per comment willing to process

ST_NGRAM_SEARCH = False

This enables search on Asian languages, and across word boundaries. It'll increase the index size. Changing this setting requires re-building the search index by running *python manage.py rebuild_index*

ST_NOTIFICATIONS_PER_PAGE = 20

Number of notifications per page

ST_NOTIFY_WHEN = 'never'

Default email notification frequency. This is applied to new users; existing users will default to 'never'. Valid values are 'never', 'immediately', and 'weekly'

ST_ORDERED_CATEGORIES = False

Enable/disable category ordering.

ST_PREVENT_SOME_FILE_DUPLICATION = False

Prevent duplication of files uploaded by a user. Including images. This is not across all users, but a single user.

Be aware the de-duplication is based on a file hash calculation, which is quite slow and it will degrade the server's performance.

All files will have the hash as name and the original file's name will be lost.

Note: Defaults to False since Spirit 0.8

ST_PRIVATE_FORUM = False

Settings this to True will require all users to be logged-in to access any section

ST_RATELIMIT_CACHE = 'st_rate_limit'

The cache ID for storing rate-limit related data. The cache ID must be a valid CACHES entry and the TIMEOUT must be None otherwise it will misbehave

ST_RATELIMIT_CACHE_PREFIX = 'srl'

The cache key prefix. This is mostly to avoid clashing with other apps

ST_RATELIMIT_ENABLE = True

Enable/disable the rate-limit for all forms

ST_RATELIMIT_SKIP_TIMEOUT_CHECK = False

A warning will be printed when the TIMEOUT is not None. Setting this to True will silence it.

Warning: A ConfigurationError will be raised instead of a warning in Spirit > 0.5

ST_SEARCH_INDEX_UPDATE_HOURS = 24

The age in hours of the items to index into the search index on each update.

The update is run by a periodic task; ex: ST_HUEY_SCHEDULE['full_search_index_update'] in case of Huey.

The task schedule for the selected ST_TASK_MANAGER will need to be set to this value (or lesser)

ST_SEARCH_QUERY_MIN_LEN = 3

Minimum length for a given search query

ST_SITE_URL = None

The forum URL, ex: "https://community.spirit-project.com/". This is used to construct the links in the emails: email verification, password reset, notifications, etc. A ImproperlyConfigured error is raised if this is not set.

ST_STORAGE = None

The media file storage for Spirit. The default file storage is used if this is not set. In either case, the storage should be set to overwrite files. Otherwise, files such as user avatar changes will waste space. Other uploaded files/images have a unique path so they are never overwritten.

ST_TASK_MANAGER = None

The task manager to run delayed and periodic tasks such as send emails, update the search index, clean up

django sessions, etc. Valid values are: 'celery', 'huey', and None. Requires running pip install django-spirit[huey] to install Huey, and pip install django-spirit[celery] to install Celery

ST_TOPIC_PRIVATE_CATEGORY_PK = 1

The category's PK containing all of the private topics. The category is auto-created and so this value should not change

ST_UNICODE_SLUGS = True

Support unicode slugs. Set to False to only allow ASCII chars

ST_UNIQUE_EMAILS = True

Reject duplicated emails when creating a new account

ST_UPLOAD_FILE_ENABLED = False

Enable/disable file uploads within posts. Requires running pip install django-spirit[files] to install python-magic

- **ST_UPLOAD_IMAGE_ENABLED = True** Enable/disable image uploads within posts
- **ST_USER_LAST_SEEN_THRESHOLD_MINUTES = 1** Threshold in minutes before the user "*last seen*" info can be updated

ST_YT_PAGINATOR_PAGE_RANGE = 3

Number of next/previous pages the paginator will show

1.6 Features

- · Categories, sub-categories, topics, and comments view system
- · Latest topic view
- Search: includes categories/sub-categories filter; the search is on topic titles, and comments; includes multibackend support: elastic-search, solr, xapian, and whoosh
- Comment pools
- · Comment likes
- Comment draft: unfinished user comments are automatically saved to local storage
- · Comment history: all edits made to a comment are saved, and displayed as diffs
- · Comment file upload, and image upload
- Double posting prevention
- · Markdown text editor for comments: includes math-jax support, emoji, embedded youtube videos, and more
- · Automatic topic bookmark: users are always taken to the last comment they read
- Private group conversations: users can create a private topic, and invite other users to join it
- Private forum: the entire forum can be set to private mode, requiring every user to be logged-in to view its content
- User unread topics: list of visited topics with unread replies
- · User notifications for replies and mentions
- User profile: includes comments, topics, and likes lists
- · User auto-generated default avatar, and custom avatar upload

- User last seen on-line
- Moderation tools: pin/stick, move, lock, and soft-delete topics; move, edit, and soft-delete comments; edit, and deactivate user accounts; lock, create, and soft-delete categories/sub-categories; comment flags system; create moderators and admins;
- Asynchronous tasks: sending emails, periodic & real-time search indexation, and email notifications
- Mobile first responsive design
